RE: ANTIDUMPING SCOPE RULING ON CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONES  
AND SUBASSEMBLIES FROM JAPAN (A-588-405).

1. ON SEPTEMBER 28, 1995, IN RESPONSE TO A REQUEST BY  
MATSUSHITA COMMUNICATIONS INDUSTRIAL CORPORATION OF AMERICA AND  
ITS RELATED ENTITIES (COLLECTIVELY, MATSUSHITA), THE DEPARTMENT  
OF COMMERCE ISSUED A FINAL SCOPE RULING FINDING THAT MATSUSHITA  
MODELS EB-3570, EB-3571, EB-3572, AND EB-3578 PORTABLE CELLULAR  
TELEPHONES (PCTS) ARE NOT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ANTIDUMPING  
DUTY ORDER ON CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONES AND SUBASSEMBLIES FROM

JAPAN.

2. THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINED THAT MATSUSHITA MODELS EB-3570, EB-3571, EB-3572, AND EB-3578 PCTS ARE POCKET-SIZED SELF-CONTAINED PCTS AND THEREFORE, NOT WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ORDER ON CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONES AND SUBASSEMBLIES FROM JAPAN.

3. EFFECTIVELY IMMEDIATELY, TERMINATE SUSPENSION AND LIQUIDATE ALL UNLIQUIDATED ENTRIES, REGARDLESS OF ENTRY DATE, OF THE MATSUSHITA MODELS EB-3570, EB-3571, EB-3572, AND EB-3578 PCTS.

4. REFUND ANY CASH DEPOSITS WITH INTEREST AND RELEASE ANY BONDS RELATING TO THE MATSUSHITA MODELS EB-3570, EB-3571, EB-3572, AND EB-3578 PCTS.

5. THE REFUND OF CASH DEPOSITS BY THE CUSTOMS SERVICE ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CUSTOMS PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST

ON UNDERPAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE OF PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

6. CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONES AND SUBASSEMBLIES SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER COVERING CELLULAR MOBILE TELEPHONES AND SUBASSEMBLIES FROM JAPAN.
