1. ON AUGUST 4, 1997, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE (COMMERCE) PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER A NOTICE OF ITS PRELIMINARY AFFIRMATIVE COUNTERVAILING DUTY (CVD) DETERMINATION AND INSTRUCTED CUSTOMS TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF SHIPMENTS OF STEEL WIRE ROD FROM VENEZUELA (62 FR 4139) ENTERED ON OR AFTER THAT DATE. IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER OF 10/22/97, COMMERCE PUBLISHED ITS NOTICE OF FINAL AFFIRMATIVE CVD DETERMINATION (62 FR 55014) AS WELL AS A NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OF THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY INVESTIGATION FOR STEEL WIRE ROD FROM VENEZUELA.

(62 FR 54966).

IMPORTS OF STEEL WIRE ROD FROM VENEZUELA THE N BECAME SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SUSPENSION AGREEMENT BETWEEN COMMERCE AND THE GOVERNMENT OF VENEZUELA ON NOVEMBER 26, 1997, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION NOTIFIED COMMERCE OF ITS NEGATIVE FINAL INJURY DETERMINATION FOR THE CVD INVESTIGATION OF STEEL WIRE ROD FROM VENEZUELA. AS A RESULT, THE SUSPENSION AGREEMENT NO LONGER HAS FORCE OR EFFECT. (SEE FINAL AFFIRMATIVE CVD DETERMINATION: STEEL WIRE ROD FROM VENEZUELA, 62 FR 55014, OCTOBER 22, 1997.)

2. FIELD OFFICES SHOULD, WITH RESPECT TO COUNTERVAILING DUTIES, DISCONTINUE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ALL SHIPMENTS OF THIS MERCHANDISE ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE ON OR

AFTER AUGUST 4, 1997. ALL ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES DEPOSITED ON ENTRY SUMMARIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SHALL BE REFUNDED AND THE BONDS OR OTHER SECURITY RELEASED AT THE TIME OF LIQUIDATION.

3.
