1. THIS MESSAGE APPLIES ONLY TO ENTRIES OF CERTAIN  
CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA  
(A-122-822) IMPORTED BY PARKDALE INTERNATIONAL LTD. ON OR AFTER  
09/26/2000 AND BEFORE 12/15/2005.

2. ON 02/09/2007, THE COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE FEDERAL CIRCUIT  
ISSUED A FINAL DECISION IN THE CASE OF CERTAIN

CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA

(A-122-822), COURT CASE 05-00316. AS A RESULT OF THIS DECISION, THE INJUNCTION TO WHICH MESSAGE # 5136207 REFERS, ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA FOR THE PERIOD 08/01/2002 THROUGH 05/05/2003 IMPORTED BY PARKDALE INTERNATIONAL LTD., DISSOLVED ON 04/25/2007.

3. ON 06/30/2009, THE COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE FEDERAL CIRCUIT DISMISSED CASE NUMBER 07-00166, CONCERNING CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA (A-122-822). AS A RESULT OF THIS DISMISSAL, THE INJUNCTION TO WHICH MESSAGE # 7313201 REFERS ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA FOR THE PERIOD ON OR AFTER 09/26/2000 IMPORTED BY PARKDALE INTERNATIONAL LTD. DISSOLVED ON 06/30/2009.

4. ACCORDINGLY, YOU ARE NOW INSTRUCTED TO LIQUIDATE ENTRIES OF CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA WHICH WERE IMPORTED BY PARKDALE INTERNATIONAL LTD. AND WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION, ON OR AFTER 09/26/2000 AND BEFORE 12/15/2005, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RELEVANT MESSAGE IDENTIFIED BELOW.

OR AFTER 12/15/2005 ARE NOT SUBJECT TO ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. SEE

6. ON 04/26/2007, THE U.S. COURT OF INTERNATIONAL TRADE ISSUED  
A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ENJOINING LIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN  
ENTRIES WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER ON  
CERTAIN CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM  
CANADA (A-122-822) PRODUCED BY DOFASCO INC., SOREVCO INC. OR DO  
SOL GALVA LTD. (AKA DOSOL GALVA, LTD.) AND IMPORTED BY OR SOLD  
TO DOFASCO INC.; OR PRODUCED BY DOFASCO INC., SOREVCO INC. OR  
DO SOL GALVA LTD. (AKA DOSOL H GALVA, LTD.) AND PROCESSED BY DJ  
GALVANIZING LTD. PARTNERSHIP (DJG) (FORMERLY DNN GALVANIZING  
LTD. PARTNERSHIP), AND IMPORTED BY OR SOLD TO DOFASCO INC., AND  
WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR  
CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 08/01/2004 THROUGH 07/31/2005.

CONTINUE TO SUSPEND LIQUIDATION OF THESE ENTRIES UNTIL

7. THESE INSTRUCTIONS CONSTITUTE NOTICE OF THE LIFTING OF  
SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES OF CERTAIN

CORROSION-RESISTANT CARBON STEEL FLAT PRODUCTS FROM CANADA

(A-122-822) IMPORTED BY PARKDALE INTERNATIONAL LTD., ON OR AFTER 09/26/2000 AND BEFORE 12/15/2005.

8. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY CBP ON SHIPMENTS OR ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CBP PAY INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDERPAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES.

THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER.

INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

9. UPON ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, CBP SHOULD REQUIRE THAT THE IMPORTER PROVIDE A REIMBURSEMENT STATEMENT AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 351.402(f)(2) COMMERCE'S REGULATIONS. THE IMPORTER SHOULD PROVIDE THE REIMBURSEMENT STATEMENT PRIOR TO LIQUIDATION OF THE ENTRY.

IF THE IMPORTER CERTIFIES THAT IT HAS AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MANUFACTURER, PRODUCER, SELLER, OR EXPORTER TO BE REIMBURSED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, CBP SHOULD DOUBLE THE ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ABOVE-REFERENCED REGULATION. ADDITIONALLY, IF THE IMPORTER DOES NOT PROVIDE THE REIMBURSEMENT STATEMENT PRIOR TO LIQUIDATION, CBP SHOULD PRESUME REIMBURSEMENT AND DOUBLE THE ANTIDUMPING DUTIES DUE.
