1. ON 12/04/2009 (74 FR 63720), COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE  
FEDERAL REGISTER ITS AMENDED PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION IN THE  
ANTIDUMPING INVESTIGATION ON POLYETHYLENE RETAIL CARRIER BAGS  
FROM INDONESIA. SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 9343002 DATED 12/09/2009.

2. TITLE 19 U.S.C. SECTION 1520(a)(4) AUTHORIZES REFUNDS PRIOR  
TO LIQUIDATION WHENEVER AN IMPORTER OF RECORD DECLARES OR IT IS  
ASCERTAINED THAT EXCESS DUTIES, FEES, CHARGES, OR EXACTIONS  
HAVE BEEN DEPOSITED OR PAID.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH 19 U.S.C. SECTION 1520(a)(4), CBP IS AUTHORIZED TO GRANT A REFUND, IF REQUESTED BY THE IMPORTER, OF ALL-OTHERS CASH DEPOSITS FOR ENTRIES OF POLYETHYLENE RETAIL CARRIER BAGS FROM INDONESIA FROM THE ENTITIES WITHOUT THEIR OWN RATE WHICH WERE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD 01/01/2008 THROUGH 12/31/2008.

3. THE REFUND AMOUNT WILL BE CALCULATED BY DETERMINING THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE AMOUNT OF CASH DEPOSITS PAID AS A RESULT OF THE APPLICATION OF THE ALL-OTHERS RATE IN THE PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION AND THE AMOUNT DUE AS A RESULT OF THE APPLICATION OF THE ALL-OTHERS RATE IN THE AMENDED PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION.

4. LISTED BELOW IS THE ALL-OTHERS DEPOSIT RATE THAT WAS ASSIGNED TO ENTITIES WITHOUT THEIR OWN RATE IN THE PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION. SEE MESSAGE NUMBER 9307203 DATED 11/03/2009. IN ADDITION, LISTED BELOW IS THE AMENDED ALL-OTHERS CASH
