1. ON 05/20/2002 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS INITIATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATIONS ON UREA AMMONIUM NITRATE SOLUTIONS FROM BELARUS, LITHUANIA, UKRAINE, AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION.
2. THE SCOPE OF THESE INVESTIGATIONS COVERS ALL MIXTURES OF UREA AND AMMONIUM NITRATE IN AQUEOUS OR AMMONIACAL SOLUTION, REGARDLESS OF NITROGEN CONTENT BY WEIGHT.

IMPORTS OF COVERED MERCHANDISE ARE CLASSIFIABLE IN THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS) UNDER ITEM NUMBER 3102.80.00. HTSUS SUBHEADINGS ARE PROVIDED FOR CONVENIENCE AND CUSTOMS PURPOSES. THE WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE SCOPE OF THIS PROCEEDING IS DISPOSITIVE.

3. FOR FURTHER REPORTING PURPOSES THESE CASES HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED INVESTIGATION NUMBERS, A-822-805, A-451-804, A-823-814, AND A-821-818.
