1. FOR ALL SHIPMENTS OF BARIUM CHLORIDE FROM THE PEOPLES
REPUBLIC OF CHINA PRODUCED BY ALL CHINESE PRODUCERS,
ENTERED OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE FOR CONSUMPTION
DURING THE PERIOD 10/01/1997 THROUGH 09/30/1998, ASSESS AN
ANTIDUMPING LIABILITY 60.84 PERCENT

2. THESE INSTRUCTIONS CONSTITUTE THE IMMEDIATE LIFTING OF
SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE
AND PERIOD LISTED ABOVE. FOR ALL OTHER SHIPMENTS OF BARIUM

CHLORIDE FROM THE PEOPLES REPUBLIC YOU SHALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED, CONTINUE TO COLLECT CASH DEPOSITS OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES FOR THE MERCHANDISE AT THE CURRENT RATES

3. THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BY THE CUSTOMS SERVICE ON ENTRIES OF THIS MERCHANDISE IS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930. SECTION 778 REQUIRES THAT CUSTOMS PAYS INTEREST ON OVERPAYMENTS, OR ASSESS INTEREST ON UNDER PAYMENTS, OF THE REQUIRED AMOUNTS DEPOSITED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES. THE INTEREST PROVISIONS ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CASH OR BONDS POSTED AS ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES BEFORE THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE ANTIDUMPING DUTY ORDER. INTEREST SHALL BE CALCULATED FROM THE DATE PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES IS REQUIRED THROUGH THE DATE OF LIQUIDATION. THE RATE AT WHICH SUCH INTEREST IS PAYABLE IS THE RATE IN EFFECT UNDER SECTION 6621 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1954 FOR SUCH PERIOD.

4. WHENEVER THE USE OF THE ABOVE VALUES RESULTS IN THE ASSESSMENT OF ANTIDUMPING DUTIES, YOU SHOULD REQUIRE OF THE IMPORTER PRIOR TO LIQUIDATION THE REIMBURSEMENT STATEMENT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 351.402 OF THE COMMERCE DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS. IMPORTERS WERE ADVISED OF THIS REQUIREMENT WHEN THE PRELIMINARY AND FINAL RESULTS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW WERE PUBLISHED IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER. IF THE IMPORTER HAS BEEN REIMBURSED ANTIDUMPING DUTIES OR FAILS TO PROVIDE THE REIMBURSEMENT STATEMENT PRIOR TO LIQUIDATION, CUSTOMS SHOULD DOUBLE THE ANTIDUMPING DUTIES DUE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ABOVE-REFERENCED REGULATION.

5.
