RE: Preliminary injunction on fresh garlic from the PRC for Shandong Jinxiang Zhengyang Imp & Exp Co., Ltd., for the period 11/01/2010 thru 10/31/2011 (A-570-831), court number 13-00240

1. On 07/25/2013, the U.S. Court of International Trade issued a preliminary injunction enjoining liquidation of certain entries which are subject to the antidumping duty order on fresh garlic from the People's Republic of China (A-570-831) for the period 11/01/2010 through 10/31/2011.
2. This injunction was issued in connection with court case number 13-00240 and enjoins liquidation of the entries described in paragraph 3 below.
3. Accordingly, until further notice, do not liquidate entries of subject merchandise which were: the subject of the administrative determination published as Fresh Garlic From the People's Republic of China: Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review; 2010-2011, 78 Fed. Reg. 36168, (June 17, 2013); exported by Shandong Jinxiang Zhengyang Import & Export Co., Ltd., and which were entered or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption between November 1, 2010 and October 31, 2011. Any entries that are set for liquidation must be unset immediately. Continue to suspend liquidation of these entries until liquidation instructions are issued.
4. Liquidation instructions for entries affected by the injunction have not yet been issued.
5. Effective immediately, CBP is instructed to prevent liquidation of any entries subject to the above.
6. Pursuant to the terms of the injunction, no liquidation of the entries covered by the injunction may be made for entries which remain unliquidated as of 5:00 p.m. on the business day after the day when the Court entered this order on the docket in this case.
7.
