RE: Scope determination on the antidumping duty order on crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules, from the People's Republic of China (A-570-979)

1. On 07/24/2013, in response to a request by Batteries Plus, LLC, Commerce issued a final scope determination that the crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells in OYAMA Life Impact Energy Co., Ltd.'s OY340-XA Hybrid Solar Tablet Charger, which Batteries Plus, LLC imports, are within the scope of the antidumping duty order on crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules, from the People's Republic of China (A-570-979).
2. Because the imported product does not have a function other than power generation and does not consume the electricity generated by the integrated crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, Commerce found its crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells to be within the scope of the order.
3. Continue to suspend liquidation of entries of crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules, from the People's Republic of China, including OYAMA Life Impact Energy Co., Ltd.'s OY340-XA Hybrid Solar Tablet Charger imported by Batteries Plus, LLC described above, subject to the antidumping duty order on crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells, whether or not assembled into modules, from the People's Republic of China.
