1. ON APRIL 24, 2001, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE WILL PUBLISH IN THE FEDERAL REGISTER ITS INITIATION OF AN ANTIDUMPING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF GREENHOUSE TOMATOES FROM CANADA.
2. THE MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO THIS INVESTIGATION CONSISTS OF ALL FRESH OR CHILLED TOMATOES GROWN IN GREENHOUSES IN CANADA, E.G., COMMON ROUND TOMATOES, CHERRY TOMATOES, PLUM OR PEAR TOMATOES,

AND CLUSTER OR "ON-THE-VINE" TOMATOES. SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED

FROM THE SCOPE OF THIS INVESTIGATION ARE ALL FIELD-GROWN TOMATOES.

THE MERCHANDISE SUBJECT TO THIS INVESTIGATION MAY ENTER UNDER 0702.00.2000, 0702.00.2010, 0702.00.2030, 0702.00.2035, 0702.00.2060, 0702.00.2065, 0702.00.2090, 0702.00.2095, 0702.00.4000, 0702.00.4030, 0702.00.4060, 0702.00.4090, 0702.00.6000, 0702.00.6010, 0702.00.6030, 0702.00.6035, 0702.00.6060, 0702.00.6065, 0702.00.6090, AND 0702.00.6095 OF THE HARMONIZED TARIFF SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES (HTSUS).
