LEATHER WEARING APPAREL FROM COLOMBIA (C-301-001)

1.The Department of Commerce published in the Federal Register of May 24, 1991, notice of its termination of the countervailing duty investigation on leather wearing apparel from Colombia.

2.The product covered by this termination is leather wearing apparel, which is currently provided for under HTS subheadings 4203.10.40.30, 4203.10.40.60, and 4203.10.40.90.

3. Field officers should no longer suspend liquidation for countervailing duty purposes on entries, or withdrawals from warehouse, of leather wearing apparel from Colombia entered on or after February 21, 1991. In addition, field officers should no longer require a cash deposit or bond on entries of the subject merchandise for countervailing duty purposes. Entries should be liquidated without regard to countervailing duty. All bonds should be released or cash deposits refunded.

4. For further reporting purposes, this countervailing duty investigation has been assigned case number C-301-001.
