1. On June 24, 1991, the Commerce Department sent instructions to proceed with liquidation of all unliquidated merchandise without regard to countervailing duties, and to refund all cash deposits and release all posted securities. These instructions were sent because the countervailing duty order for fresh, chilled, and frozen pork from Canada was revoked. (Email #1182111 dated July 1, 1991)

2. The Commerce Department was informed by Customs that the

instructions regarding the period April 1, 1991, through June 24, 1991, were unclear.

3. This is to clarify the original instructions: Entries between April 1, 1991, through June 24, 1991, should also be liquidated and cash deposits should be refunded and posted securities should be released.
