1. ON NOVEMBER 13, 2001, THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION (ITC) NOTIFIED THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE OF ITS NEGATIVE FINAL DETERMINATION IN THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF PURE MAGNESIUM FROM ISRAEL. THE COUNTERVAILING DUTY INVESTIGATION OF PURE MAGNESIUM FROM ISRAEL HAS THEREFORE BEEN TERMINATED.

2. ON JUNE 27, 2001, THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE DISCONTINUED THE SUSPENSION OF LIQUIDATION OF ALL SHIPMENTS OF

THIS MERCHANDISE ENTERED, OR WITHDRAWN FROM WAREHOUSE, FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR AFTER JUNE 22, 2001, WHICH WAS 120 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF PUBLICATION OF THE PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION. (SEE MESSAGE NO. 1178201.) ALL ESTIMATED COUNTERVAILING DUTIES DEPOSITED ON ENTRIES OF THE SUBJECT MERCHANDISE SHALL BE REFUNDED AND THE BONDS OR OTHER SECURITY RELEASED AT THE TIME OF LIQUIDATION.

3. INTEREST PROVISIONS OF SECTION 778 OF THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930 DO NOT APPLY.
