1. The Department of Commerce published in the Federal Register on January 28, 1992, its initiation of antidumping duty investigations of potassium hydroxide, liquid and dry, from Canada, Italy and the United Kingdom.

2. The merchandise subject to these investigations is all grades of potassium hydroxide (KOH,) liquid and dry. Imports of this product are currently classifiable under the Harmonized Tariff

Schedule (HTS) subheading 2815.20.0000. The HTS subheading is provided for convenience and customs purposes. Our written description of the scope of these investigations is dispositive .

3. For further reporting purposes, these cases have been assigned investigation numbers A-122-817 (Canada), A-475-804 (Italy), and A-412-808 (United Kingdom).

4. Liquidation of entries is not to be suspended without specific instruction.
